
Nominations for Gifted Identification Being Accepted

This is the time of year when we accept nominations for gifted identification of students. The parent nomination is only one consideration in a multi-factored identification process and does not guarantee identification and/or services. We are proud to offer many advanced academic opportunities in our school district throughout the grade levels, most of which are not limited to only gifted students. A rigorous curriculum is provided to all children whenever academically appropriate, regardless of gifted identification.

If you are not sure if your child exhibits characteristics/traits typical of that of a gifted child please review information available on the Bellbrook-Sugarcreek Schools' website. If your child is already a member of a gifted classroom, and you are unsure whether or not to nominate in other academic areas, please check with your child's teacher. Also, gifted identification in mathematics does not guarantee placement in accelerated mathematics classes. Acceleration decisions may require additional testing and committee approval per Bellbrook-Sugarcreek Schools' board policy number 5410.
