Bellbrook High School is located in Greene County, southeast of Dayton, Ohio. It is the high school of the Bellbrook-Sugarcreek School District. The district is rural and suburban and consists of the City of Bellbrook (population 7100) and Sugarcreek Township (population 8200). Every year approximately 2 members of the senior class receive recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program. The class of 2019 had 3 Semi-Finalists.

**School Code:** 360-385

**Faculty:** There are 55 faculty members and more than 75% hold advanced degrees.

**Advanced Placement:** Formal Advanced Placement courses are offered in: Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, Environmental Science, Spanish Language, French Language, Music Theory, Biology, Chemistry, English Language and English Literature, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Government and Politics – U.S., and U.S. History. Advanced Placement Examination: In May of 2018, 157 students took 283 exams. Eighty-one percent of test takers received a 3, 4 or 5. Advanced Placement classes do receive weight for GPA.

**Honors/Scholarship Classes:** Honors level English courses are offered in the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades. Scholarship courses are offered in Mathematics at all grade levels. Grades earned in these courses do receive extra weighting for GPA.

**Career Education Programs:** Bellbrook High School is affiliated with The Greene County Career Center located just outside of Xenia, Ohio. The Career Center offers over 20 program choices. Project Lead the Way, a national pre-college engineering program, was introduced at BHS during the 2007-2008 school year.

**College Credit Plus Option:** In the 2018-19 school year, over 200 students took courses for college credit, both on campus at BHS and at local colleges/universities. Credit is awarded and grades are weighted in the GPA. Current College Credit Plus courses at BHS are: Spanish III, Spanish IV, Supply Chain Management, Chinese, College English 12, AP Statistics, Multivariable Calculus, Intro to Engineering, Digital Electronics, Civil Engineering and Architecture, Engineering Development and Design, and EGR 1010.
