Old Business:

- Winter Invitational
 - The MEPA Bellbrook Invitational will be held on 20Feb2021 at Bellbrook High School. As of 11Jan2021, there are 16 groups that have registered for the event: four groups from Bellbrook and 12 groups from outside schools.

New Business:

 - <u>8th Grade Information night</u>: Directors Andy Soloman and Barb Siler report that there was a "good" turnout for 8th Grade Night, including three Bellbrook Online Academy (BOA) students.
- Winter Invitational
 - Concessions:
 - Mr. Soloman spoke to AD Mr. O'Dell about concessions at the Bellbrook Home Basketball games. The profit from each game has been approximately \$30. Due to the low return vs investment, it was decided that there will be no concessions at this year's Winter Invitational.
 - The Food Committee (Becky Hobbs, Deb Goffinett, and Jenna Hosler) will take charge of a paired down Hospitality Room that we be for MEPA staff and judges only. Per Wyatt Hines, our MEPA Contest Admin, there will be 5 judges and 12-15 MEPA staff.

- Sanitizing:
 - Large mops and buckets (2+) will be at our disposal to clean bleachers. We will also have access to sprayers with sanitizing solution and wipes. All will be provided by BHS.
 - **o** Bellbrook HS Custodians will be working the day of the Invitational cleaning the bathrooms.
 - For warmup areas, high contact points- door handles, will need to be wiped down in between groups.

Livestreaming/Recording of the Event:

- <u>o</u> Bellbrook is NOT allowed to use it's inhouse recording system to record the entirety of the Invitational.
- o___Directors are encouraged to record their groups.
- <u>o</u> Parents CAN facetime or livestream the event as long as they are not distracting, and they don't post on Social Media.
- Tickets:
 - <u>o</u> We will not be selling tickets at the door, so there will be no exchange of money. If there are extra tickets, spectators may buy them from the MEPA website, and then show us their confirmation.
 - <u>o</u> Spectators will need to show their E ticket on their phone or a paper copy. We will need to verify that they have arrived for the correct Block.
 - **<u>o</u>** Every Block will have a different color wristband.

- Indoor Percussion has learned 2 movements of "Moving Parts" with music inspired by the piano writing of Sergei Rachmaninoff. Their first performance is this Sunday, 2/7 at 10:09am at the MEPA Northmont Competition.
- Winter guard has pretty much learned their show, "The Nutcracker," and will be making a video recording this week for their first virtual evaluation.
- Winter Invitational is scheduled for Saturday, February 20th. Details are still in the works with the district and MEPA as far as what this event will look like. Here are some updates:
 - Limited seating/ticketing
 - Limited chaperone/pit dad passes
 - Shorter show days for students (we are not allowed to go back in and watch, and there will be no awards retreat at the conclusion)

- Tickets will be for a short "block" of a few groups. This will mean that spectators can watch up to a few groups before or after their group performs
- After each "block" of performances, the bleachers are cleared and new spectators are allowed in
- About 8 blocks, with 2-3 groups per block
- MEPA show dates have been announced and IPE shows are listed on the Bellbrook Music Department Google Calendar
- IPE and Winterguard will both be participating in WGI Virtual World Championships in late March/early April
- Marching Band Summer Schedule has been shared with 8th graders and will be shared with everyone this week
