Old Business:

- **Winter Invitational Wrap Up**

Monday, March 1, 2021

- Thank you thank you thank you for an amazing winter invitational! It was (pretty much) seamless. Our boosters are definitely the BEST!
- The John Mackey commission is ON!!
- Spring Concert Dates are set! Our current plan is to use the same livestream setup as our December concerts.
 - Wednesday, March 3rd: 6th Grade
 - Tuesday, March 16: Choir
 - Wednesday, March 24: HS Band
 - Thursday, March 25: 7th/8th Grade
- We plan to live stream March high school and middle school (7th/8th grade) concerts AS WELL AS have an in-person audience. We probably need booster help for this!
- Preliminary surveys for course signups were completed by each class - retention for concert band is GREAT.....working on the marching band side :-)
- Indoor Percussion is working on their 3rd and final movement of the show. Our score summary has improved every show, and we have received great feedback from judges as well as AMAZING in-person applause from audience members at our shows. The next performances are March 14th at Centerville, March 26th (Command Performance) and March 28th at Hamilton
- Winter guard has competed in person as well as virtually. They're having a great season. Recording again tomorrow night.
