● **Administrator's Report**

- Not present at this time, but the Administration continues to offer their full organizational and logistical support to all of Bellbrook's Music Programs.

● **Fall Invitational**

- MSBA Bellbrook will take place on 02Oct2021.
- There are currently two bands registered to compete, and Bellbrook's Marching Band will be in exhibition.
- An Invitational Planning Meeting will be on 30Aug2021 at 6:30 pm in the BHS Cafeteria. All are invited and encouraged to attend.

● **Fundraising**

▪ **Dine Outs:**

Next Dine Out: 17Aug2021 at BJ's Brewhouse at Austin Landing.

Following Dine Out: 14Sept2021 at Chipotle in Sugarcreek Plaza.

We still have an ongoing fundraising effort at Buffalo Wild Wings. Tell them that you are part of "Team C", and 10% of your bill, excluding alcohol, will go to the Music Boosters. Bills must be paid in-person, not online, in order for the funds to go to the Boosters. Bellbrook/Wilmington Pike location only.

▪ **Lego Raffle Fundraiser:**

The fundraiser is being sponsored by The Dayton Brick Shop. They will be raffling four Lego sets that retail for a total of \$550. One winner will receive all four sets. There will only be a total of 300 tickets sold for the raffle, which increase the odds of winning. The Dayton Brick Shop will sell 100 of those tickets, and the Boosters will be given the other 200 tickets to sell.

The plan is for each student to be responsible for selling two tickets each, at \$5 apiece. The student will be given the tickets once they bring in the money. Nick Falzerano will be responsible for collecting funds and distributing tickets.

The Dayton Brick Shop is willing to do multiple such fundraisers each year, each netting \$1,000 for the Boosters. There is no risk involved or financial contribution from the Boosters, so it is a complete "win, win" endeavor.

▪ **Winter Poinsettia and Porch Pot Sale:**

Heather Newell will contact Sarah at Berns to ascertain if they intend on having the fundraiser again this year. Sarah had stated in May Berns was unsure of their plans for Winter 2021.

▪ **Spring Flower Sale:**

Karen Beildchies has volunteered to chair the 2022 Spring Flower sale. She intends on recruiting a co-chair for the event. She will meet with Heather Newell this month to discuss the previous sale and hand off pertinent information. Finding a new nursery to work with for the fundraiser will be the current priority.

Open Forum

- **Sponsorships:**

- Brett Woeste discussed the production and application of the banners and truck decals that companies sponsoring our Music Program for 2021-2022 were promised.
- Sponsorship cost to increase to \$550. For that price, the sponsor will receive:
 - A 10"x 18" decal on both Big Bird and the box truck. (BMB cost=\$22 each)
 - A banner that will be on the fencing surrounding the softball field, as you enter the stadium. (BMB cost=\$50 each) There will be an introductory banner, stating: "The Bellbrook Music Program is sponsored by: "
 - Advertising space in both the Fall and Winter Invitational Programs.
- Ernst Concrete has donated \$2,000 for the new pad underneath the scaffolding, and Tom's Mulch has donated \$1200 worth of fencing, so both of these companies will receive banners, gratis.

- **Band Accomplishment Banners:**

- Nick Falzerano stated that he has received approval from AD, Mr. O'Dell, for two band banners that will go on the wall in the main BHS gymnasium.
- One banner will be for Marching Band accomplishments, while the second will be shared by IPE and World Guard for their accomplishments.
- Nick will have the banners created, and they will be put up once both are completed.

- **Concrete Pad/Fencing for Scaffolding Eagle Scout Project:**

- This project by Connor Flannagan is underway.
- They are currently removing the tower scaffolding and will be adding a concrete pad to go underneath the scaffolding. A 6-foot fence will then be erected around the pad for safety.
- Brett Woeste states that they are currently waiting to see if Lowe's will be donating money for additional supplies.

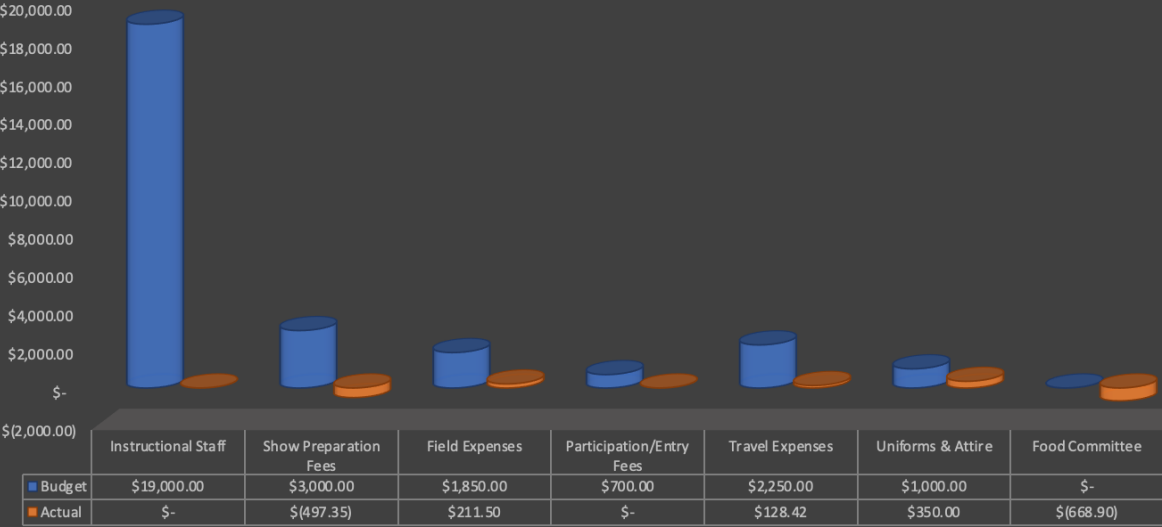

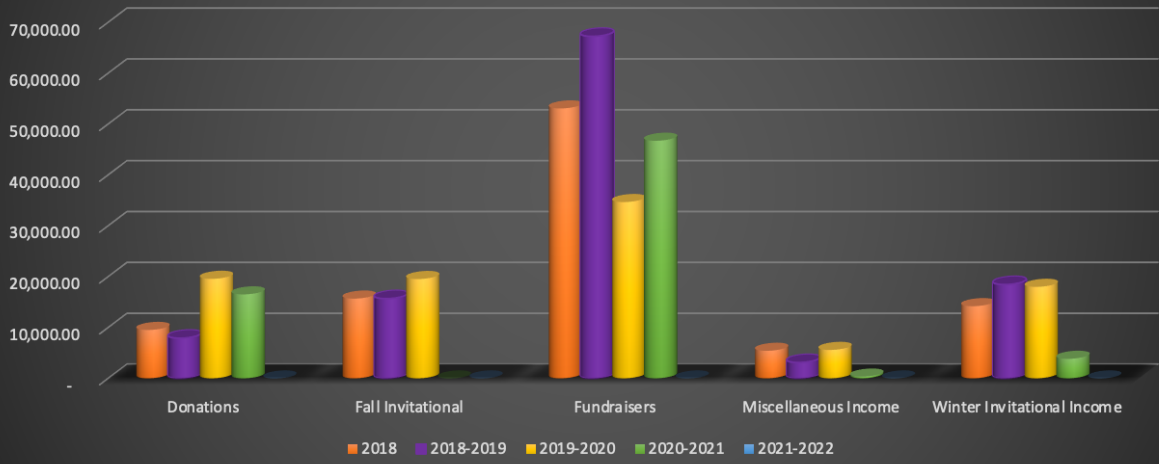

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2021 - 2022 MARCHING BAND BUDGET VS. ACTUAL

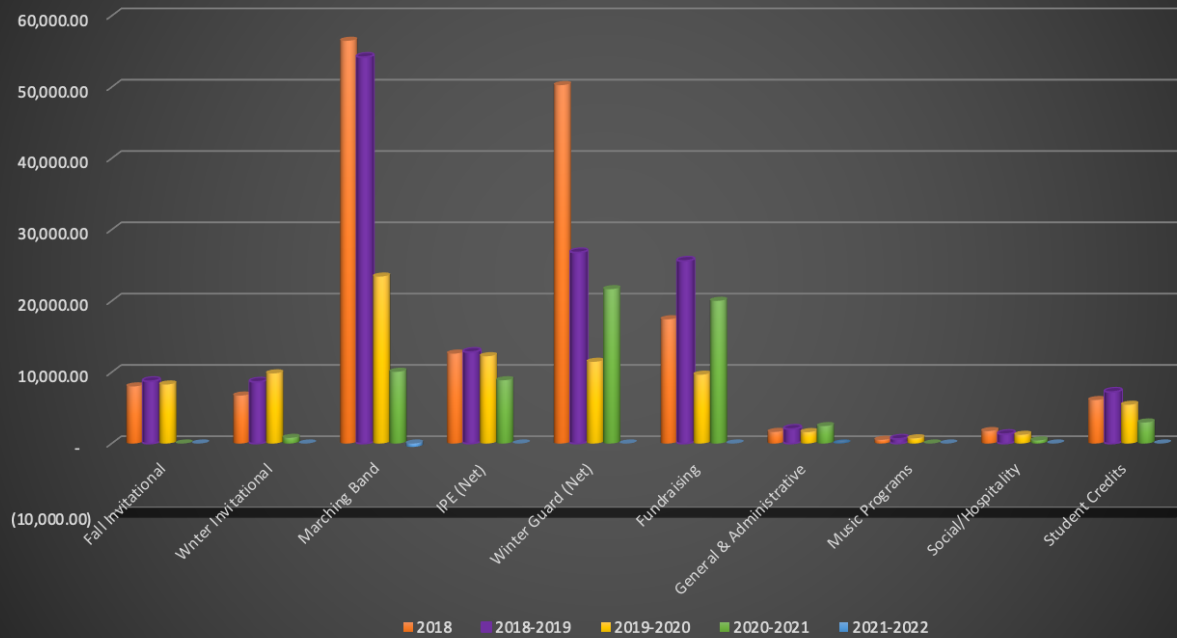


Income - Year over Year
