 - Karen clarified by asking Sheldon if the \$25,000 will be available in the account for reimbursement.
 - Additional spend outside of the budgeted items above the boosters ask and should be reimbursed from the school account back to the boosters in about \$3000.
 - Sheldon stated that some people have not paid their guard fees yet.

- Michaela asked questions about how the contacts are giving out to techs/contractors to ensure that we are paying people on time and correctly.
 - Sheldon explained that he would like to see the contacts streamlined into some type of link on the website that they sign and is submitted online to make it less of an issue trying to track down all of the paper contracts.
- Rachele brought up the contracts we give out to the techs/contractors have some outdated wording on the contracts.
 - Barb brought up that Booster Leadership and the School Board
 Treasurer Kevin Liming or his assistant
- Sheldon brought up the contract language in someone's contract that stated information about booster reimbursement for travel to regionals for Winger Guard in the amount of \$223. Andy and Barb are the deciding directors on approval of the request.
 - Karen is trying to understand if there is an actual ask for this travel or if there isn't an ask at all.
 - Sheldon did state that there is a staff member room available, but significant others cannot stay in the room.

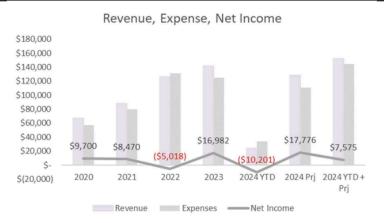

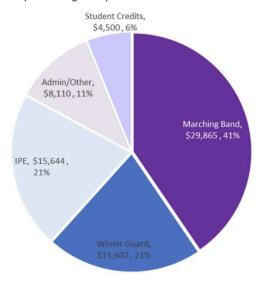
