Please be patient with us as we are busy preparing to serve over six-hundred students in BOA in order to honor your desire to keep your family safe. We are engaged in facilitator training, learning platform data imports, and final staff assignments full time in order to kick off a great year. We also continue to field many inquiries from families and are doing our best to communicate in a timely fashion.

# Your next step!

## Talk as a family

Online learning poses unique challenges and it should not be viewed as an easier alternative to face to face education. I will have high expectations and will be monitoring your child's progress very closely. Daily engagement is expected as we are required by the Ohio Department of Education to monitor online attendance which encompases student timely completion of assignments, mastery of content, online presence, and active participation. You should expect your child to spend at least four to five hours actively engaged in schoolwork each day. This time is expected to be a combination of online module work as well as independent reading, hands-on/project work and traditional homework and assessments within the modules. Here is an example of how to budget your student's time each subject per day:

# Example Time Allocation depending on student need, pace of work, etc.

- ELA=60-90 minutes
- Math= 50 minutes
- Science= 50 minutes
- Social Studies= 50 minutes
- Electives= 50 minutes
- Additional time with BHS Content Area Specialists (see below)
  - Google meets, email, and/or phone call support

You too, will be able to monitor your child's progress and grades and we will provide information to guide you in this process. Active family engagement is critical for your child's success. Grades earned in the Edmentum online platform will transfer to Bellbrook-Sugarcreek records in order to produce the traditional report card you are accustomed to.
