

Food Committee Activity Report 2013

Cheryl Sooy and Vicki Dodson were the Food Committee Chairs for this year. Todd Charlesworth started taking over in preparation for 2014 since both Cheryl and Vicki will not be here next year. We had great support throughout the season to help prepare, serve and clean up after each meal. Without the experience of Cheryl and Vicki along with the support of other parents and family members, there is no way we could have made this year happen.

At the start of the year, we got the list of the planned performances along with the requested meals associated with them from the Fosters. The initial request was for the following:

- Jul. 25th - Band Camp (Pizza Night)
- Aug. 31st - Northmont (if we had enough funds)
- Sep. 28th - Toledo (Lunch, Dinner and Snack)
- Oct. 11th - 8th Grade night
- Oct. 26th - Centerville (if we had enough funds)
- Nov. 9th - Indy Super Regionals (Lunch Dinner and Snack)
- Nov. 14th - Indy Grand Nationals (Dinner and Snack)
- Nov. 15th - Indy Grand Nationals (Lunch, Dinner and Snack)
- Nov. 16th - Indy Grand Nationals (Lunch, Dinner and Snack)

We were also provided with a tentative count of meals for each event, the total was 155 people. I added in an additional 10 to 15 people for those meals when we would be feeding the Pit Dads too.

- 120 Students
- 12-15 Chaperons
- 15-20 Staff

When we put together the initial meal plan, the cost estimates did not leave enough money for Northmont but we planned funding to include Centerville. We also said that we would do 8th Grade night but the money would need to come from another budget besides the Food Committee in order to provide all the other meals. We started the year with a budget of \$4,500.

We got an additional \$500 added to the Food Committee budget on Aug. 12 so that we could cover dinner for the Northmont performance. We also changed the meal schedule, cutting out the Centerville meal in order to feed the Band for the Kettering performance (Sept 21). Centerville was added back in to the schedule with an additional \$100 Food Committee budget increase on Oct. 7. The Middle School Band paid for all of 8th Grade night instead of splitting the cost with the Boosters.

The Trimbach's gave the Boosters a \$400 donation from their company and they specifically designated that the money go to the Food Committee. With their donation, it brought the Food Committee budget up to \$5,500 for the year.

During the initial Food Committee meeting with the Fosters and the Booster Officers, Mr. Foster said that the school paid for the gas for the school van and we just needed to turn in the receipts to him. With the school, paying for the transportation costs it saves the Boosters some money but it might be better to let the Boosters pay for the gas through Scrip cards and let the school reimburse them. As of the end of December the Charlesworth family was still waiting for any reimbursement from the school.

The Food Committee was asked to provide the food for the Band Alumni Night just a couple of weeks before the event. The cost of the food for Alumni Night was covered by the Alumni and not from the Food Committee or Booster budget. We came in about \$200 under budget on the food used for the Alumni meal.

In order to provide a complete picture of the Food Committee for the 2013 Marching season we have included three attachments that we used throughout the year.

Attachment 1 is the 2013 Marching Meal Plan. The Marching Meal Plan has all of the specific details as to what meals were served, what was bought and how well it was eaten. The second page of the Marching Meal Plan includes all of the cost data for the year, showing cost per meal, Scrip cards used, Requests for Payments, and gas charges. There are specific pages for each event as well as a page for general supply items purchased. Those items listed without a cost were either leftover from previous events or paid for by the Charlesworth family. There are some additional notes embedded in the Excel Spreadsheet pages but due to size and printing capability, they are not included but can be obtained from Todd Charlesworth as needed.

Attachment 2 is the 2013 Food Survey. At the Awards Banquet, we asked students to fill out a food survey so that we could use the data to improve the meals for next year. We wanted to know what the students liked, did not like, and will then compare it with what they ate. We had 47% of the students participate in the survey. The yellow highlighted areas in the survey show where the majority of the responses fell, some items had a tie, like the pickle spears. In the future, we will consider providing other options to replace those items highlighted on the far left of the survey.

Attachment 3 is the 2013 Price Comparison. This year we got a free membership to Restaurant Depot in Cincinnati, which was an additional avenue to the local retailers used in the past. We used Sam's Club, Gordon Food Service (GFS) and Restaurant Depot for most of our purchases. The price comparison shows the cost of the items at the time of inventory but the prices did change some throughout the year and varied depending on if we made the purchase here in Ohio or if we used the stores in Indiana during Grand Nationals. There were times that Restaurant Depot was the cheapest but due to the schedule; we were not able to make the trip to Cincinnati so we used a local retailer instead.

We decided not to ask any retailers for food donations for the Bird Feeder in an effort to allow those coordinating food for the Invitational concession stand greater success. We felt that if we were all asking for donations it would overwhelm the retailers and diminish the Boosters efforts as a whole.

At different times this year, the Food Committee had to barrow a number of items in order to prepare and serve some of the meals. We barrowed three roaster ovens, four 7-gallon water jugs, four chafing dishes, a set of knives, two extension cords, and an 8000-watt generator. The Charlesworth family also bought and donated two commercial pasta strainers to go with the 20-quart stockpots already in the Bird Feeder, as well as replacing the two regulator hoses on the propane burners.

Throughout the season, we found that it was sometimes hard to gage the amount of food to prepare. Sometimes this was because we did not have a good count as to how many Staff or Pit Dads would be eating. Sometimes it was just because we never knew how much the kids would eat because they were not consistent. There were times that we ran low on food (those helping with the Bird Feeder did not eat) and there were times that we threw away food. We have started working with the Bellbrook Sugarcreek Family Resource Center as an option of getting unused food into the hands of those in need rather than have it end up in the trash. We also found out that when food is returned to Sam's Club and other stores they have to throw it all away because of company policy and the fact that they cannot guarantee the quality of the food. In the future, we will look at donating the food to those in need rather than return it to the store for a refund.

After Grand Nationals, we had \$561.78 left based on the Requests for Payment that had been submitted. We were going to buy a new grill, the exact model and manufacture as the one currently in the Bird Feeder and a utility cart for moving food and drinks but we did not get approval to spend the rest of the Food Committee budget on these items because they were deemed capital purchases by the Booster Officers. After the Food Committee got confirmation from the Treasure about our remaining balance, we did not have the time, nor were we prepared to spend the funds on other items. The Trimbach's \$400 and the rest of the unused funds were turned back into the general booster fund. We have learned that all capital purchases need approval from the Booster Trustees even though those requirements, and what constitutes a capital purchase, are not written in any of the Bellbrook Music Boosters, Corp. Policies.

There was a Gehl Foods cheese dispenser in the Bird Feeder but the dispensing button was missing and the base was broken. We contacted the company to get repair parts and found out that the dispenser (Serial number HT2 0126144) was under a lease agreement with another company and did not belong to the Bellbrook Music Boosters, Corp. In order to do anything with the dispenser we would have to transfer the lease to the Boosters. The base was not repairable so the dispenser needed replaced, at a cost of \$100. Because of the cost to replace the dispenser and the fact that it is rarely used it was decided (by both the Booster Officers and Food Committee) to return the broken dispenser to Gehl Foods as required by the lease. Because the dispenser was so old and the cost of shipping was more than the dispenser was worth, Gehl Foods asked us to dispose of it.

There are a number of areas that need addressed in order to continue and/or improve operating the Bird Feeder in the future, these are listed below. While some of these items are within the capability of the Food Committee to correct, the majority will require the attention of the Bellbrook Music Boosters, Corp.

(1) With the loss of Vicki from the Food Committee, we are looking for someone who can help drive the school van while towing the 24-foot trailer, someone who can lift heavy items and is willing to miss performances if needed in order to provide meals for the Band.

(2) There are spots on the roof of the Bird Feeder that are leaking water. We have not been able to pin point where the water is coming in but it needs to be fixed. Some of the water is getting under the linoleum and it is starting to peel up around the edges. Unless someone can find the spots that need to be fixed the trailer needs to be taken into a dealer so they can repair the roof before additional damage is done. These repairs need to be approved by the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(3) The bottom left hinge on the side door handle/lock is coming off. With the correct tools, it might be able to be tightened but we do not currently have the correct tools. This repair might also need to be accomplished by a professional but that would require approval from the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(4) There is currently no tie down points attached to the frame of the Bird Feeder so we are not able to secure heavy objects without causing damage to other parts of the Bird Feeder. There needs to be 6 to 8 tie down rings added to the floor, properly secured to the trailer frame, to allow for safe transport of heavy equipment and food items. The purchase and installation of tie down rings would need to be approved by the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(5) There is currently one small 2000-watt inverter (generator) with the Bird Feeder. The generator does not provide enough power to work the food warmer and any additional power requirements. We have had to use roaster ovens on a number of occasions and borrowed the Charlesworth's 8000-watt generator. The 2000-watt generator works great for running the fridge, freezer and lights while on the road but additional power is needed for any cooking. The size of a new generator would need to be based on heating requirements and any new equipment. A new generator purchase would need to be approved by the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(6) Our current food warmer was donated some time ago and is a nice asset but it does not consistently maintain the required temperature. Bacteria multiply when hot food is not maintained above 135 degrees. This means that we could be feeding the Band contaminated food that could lead to illness. The thermostat control knob on the warmer is broken off inside and needs repaired. I am hoping that this is an easy fix; we have a parent willing to see if they can fix it, but it is above the Food Committee capabilities and may require additional funds.

(7) The grill that we are currently using is one purchased from Sam's for about \$400. It works OK most of the time but it is falling apart. The windscreen is coming off, the drip pans are missing, the wheels have flat spots, and we have to watch the stand to ensure that it does not fold while moving it. It would be great to replace it with a commercial grade model with a hood but I am not sure that a \$2,000 - \$3,000 grill would really increase our capability that much. I think that replacing it with the same model/manufacture would be adequate. The purchase of any new grill would have to be approved by the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(8) Our fridge does not maintain the proper temperature. Even with it turned as cold as it can go it maintains a temperature around 50 degrees. Cold foods need to be stored below 41 degrees or we risk bacteria multiplying and feeding the Band contaminated food. In order to keep the fridge at or below the required temperature we have to store ice in it with the other food. I am not sure if the fridge just needs repaired or how long it will be before it needs replaced. Again, any additional funds spent to repair or replace the fridge need to be approved by the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(9) Because of the current cooking capabilities of the Bird Feeder, we are somewhat limited to the meals that we can provide. In order to expand our capabilities we have looked at getting a commercial convection oven. Todd Charlesworth sent letters to eight different convection oven manufactures asking for a donation or discount. Requests were also sent to three local distributors. We have received very little response back. We are looking specifically at the half size countertop models, which run between \$1,000 and \$2,000. A commercial convection oven would be a great asset for the Bird Feeder and Band but it is something that would need to be worked by the Booster Trustees and added into the budget.

(10) When preparing the 2014 Food Committee budget there we need to remember to looked at:

- Ice, which committee budget does it fall under and how much is used
- Cups, does the Food Committee buy all the cups, to include those set out by Pit Dads
- Ice Cream Social, does this fall under the Food Committee or Social Committee budget
- Handbook Meeting food, are we going to have food and does this fall under the Food Committee or Social Committee budget
