

2014 Food Committee Report

This was another good year for the Bellbrook Music Boosters Food Committee. Todd Charlesworth was the committee chair/Food Manager for 2014. We had great support from many families/parents throughout the season to help prepare, serve and clean up after each meal. Without the support of other parents and family members, there is no way we could have made this year happen.

At the start of the year, we got the list of the planned performances along with the requested meals associated with them from the Fosters. The initial request was for the following:

- Jul. 24th - Band Camp (Pizza Night)
- Sep. 27th - Dayton (Dinner)
- Oct. 4th - Toledo (Lunch, Dinner and Snack)
- Oct. 10th - 8th Grade night
- Oct. 25 - Indy Super Regionals (Lunch Dinner and Snack)
- Nov. 1st - Centerville (Dinner, was cancelled for Osaka dinner)
- Nov. 13th - Indy Grand Nationals (Dinner and Snack)
- Nov. 14th - Indy Grand Nationals (Lunch, Dinner and Snack)
- Nov. 15th - Indy Grand Nationals (Lunch, Dinner and Snack)

We used a tentative count of 130 people for most event meals. I added in an additional 10 to 15 people for those meals when we would be feeding the Pit Dads too.

The Food Committee had a budget of \$5,500 for the season. The Food Committee did not cover the cost of ice because it had its own budget line. Gordon Food Service (GFS) sent the Music Boosters a \$45 gift card, based on our 2013 purchases, which the Food Committee used in addition to the annual Committee budget. We also received a \$10 Sam's Club gift card when we renewed the Music Boosters membership; the Food Committee used it in addition to the annual Committee budget too. The total amount spent against the Food Committee budget line for the year was \$5,207.27, leaving \$292.73 in the budget line, which we returned to the general Booster fund. The Food Committee maintains copies of all the receipts and requests for payment submitted if additional documentation is required.

We made a number of improvements to the Bird Feeder trailer throughout the season:

Through donations and support of the Dayton Sam's Club (1111 Miamisburg-Centerville Road), negotiated by Dionne Luedtke, we were able to exchange the old propane grill for a new one (same make/model). Mike and Sam Hill took care of the transportation and assembly of the new grill.

We were also able to get a new Gentron 10,000W Generator due to a Sam's Club donation to the Music Boosters. The cost of the generator went through the general fund budget line instead of the Food Committee budget line. Attachment 2 has additional information about the new generator.

Todd and Nathaniel Charlesworth cleaned up most of the rust spots on the wheel rims and around the doors then repainted them. We are trying to make sure that our maintenance and upkeep preserve the trailer for a long time to come.

Mike Hill and Rick Bozard purchased and painted the trailer roof with Gardner Sta-Kool 770 Cool Roof Elastomeric Coating to help prevent water leaks and any further damage to the trailer.

Jim Kreider took the food warmer apart in an attempt to repair the thermostat and provide better temperature control. The electrical wiring had been configured, at some point in the past, to by-passed the thermostat so the only options are off or full on. Jim is still looking at the options for repairing or replacing the thermostat. We also bought some insulation and installed it on the food warmer to help maintain the correct temperature inside the warmer.

The Food Committee used some of their budget to purchase a two shelf utility cart. The cart is very useful to move the water jugs, food and other large items back and forth from the Bird Feeder to the serving area.

Todd Charlesworth purchased and installed six 1,000-pound capacity tie down rings in the floor of the trailer. The tie down rings are used to strap in the generator and other items while driving to prevent any damage from movement.

Mark Linkhart, school district head mechanic, replaced all four tires on the trailer on Oct. 6th/7th with "D" rated tires. These are a higher rated tire, which should help due to the weight of the trailer.

The complete 2014 Marching Meal Planner, attachment 1, contains the complete information about the meals served, costs, amounts and additional feedback for each event. Here are some of the highlights and areas of concern for those events.

Ice Breaker - Although the Food Committee provides the ice cream for the Ice Breaker, the cost of the food comes from the hospitality budget line, not the Food Committee budget line. The Booster Trustees helped serve the ice cream.

Band Camp - We did not do the usual ice cream sandwiches with dinner, instead, the Food Committee provided cobbler for everyone before the talent show/skit night. The cobbler seemed to be a success and something that I would like to do again. We need to see if it is possible to get one Dominos Scrip card with all the money loaded on it instead of using 20 cards.

Family Picnic - We had a good turnout from the families and the donations we received covered all but about \$100 of the complete cost. I would love to have a bigger turnout and maybe have an activity or something for the families to do. I would also like to do this event again.

Dayton BOA - We were stuck with a crowded location when it came time to eat. I would recommend that we take the Bird Feeder down in the morning next year, if we have a similar schedule. Even if we just go early and set up the trailer and tables, at least we would have a spot staked out.

Toledo BOA - The weather during the Toledo competition was cold this year, which helped make the hot sandwiches a bigger success, something warm in their belly on a cold day. On the return trip home, we had a tire blow out on the trailer. Unfortunately, it was while we were in a construction zone, blocked on both sides, and we could not get off for a while. All that was left of the left rear tire was part of the sidewall. A local police officer did stop and offer assistance. Jim Hanson and Jim Kreider were both riding with us on this trip and the extra help was greatly appreciated. We did find out that the jack in the trailer is broken and needs thrown out.

Eighth Grade Night - We tried something different and got some sausage pizza this year. It is good that the Middle School Band funds helps cover the cost of the pizza.

Indianapolis Super Regional - The band performed in finals exhibition and could not come eat dinner until after their performance. Pasta tends to dry out when we have to hold it in the warmer for a couple of hours. It would be nice to see about doing a snack for the kids, in the event they are not able to eat dinner until after finals. We rented the conference room at the Comfort Suites but the money came from a different budget line instead of from the Food Committee. The hotel started their own catering, and charged us a \$50 gratuity fee, in addition to the cost for the room rental, for not using their service.

Hot Chocolate night - We ended up doing this after a home football game, on a cold rainy day. Jenna Hosier and Denise Aguila made goodies to go with the Hot Chocolate, which helped make this an awesome treat for the Band.

Indianapolis Grand Nationals - We need to look into buying all of the food for Nationals in Fishers except for Thursday's meals, because there is usually some down time Thursday after dinner. We also need to look at getting all of the Arby's Scrip funds loaded onto one card instead of taking 50 of them. Due to the size of our order at Arbys, we caused their computer system to crash, making it so they could not provide us with a copy of our last receipt; attachment 3 is a copy of the missing receipt letter submitted to the Booster Treasure.

There has been some concern that the trailer is over its gross weight limit, so after losing a tire on the way home from Toledo we took the trailer to a public scale and had it weighted. The total weight without anything but the basic trailer equipment was 7500 pounds, 500 pounds over the max axle limit. Rick Bozard addressed our concern to the school district superintendent and the head mechanic; both felt that there was no need to change anything except for the new tires already installed. Any water, propane, gas, or food transported in the trailer puts additional weight and stress on the already overloaded trailer axles.

Once again, we went through Chris Foster to seek reimbursement from the school district for the cost to refuel the school van used to tow the Bird Feeder. Reimbursement is extremely slow and was finally received on 6 Feb. 15. Although it is great that the school district is willing to cover the cost of the fuel it becomes a real burden to have to wait so long to get the money returned. In the future, we will just apply the cost of fuel against the Food Committee budget. If the Booster officers want to work to get reimbursement from the school, for the Boosters, that is their call, but the Food Committee will include it in their annual budget plan.

This year we chose to refill the propane tanks at ACE Hardware rather than exchange them. Although this does take more time the propane seems to last longer and saves us money over all.

Maintaining proper food temperatures (cold and hot) continues to be a concern. We use a thermometer in the freezer, fridge and warmer to try to keep food out of the “Danger Zone” in which bacteria multiply. When foods fall into the danger zone (41 to 135 degrees) we increase the possibility of giving the band members and accompanying adult food poisoning.

At the end of the marching season, we asked the students and chaperones to fill out a survey (attachment 4). The majority of the feedback is positive, but it is clear that there is not any one thing we serve that everyone likes. Some of the items that one group like another group did not like. More fresh fruit was one of the items mentioned multiple times. The Food Committee maintains the completed food surveys if additional information is required.

Recommendations:

Replace the axles and wheel assemblies on the Bird Feeder, if approved and funded by the Boosters. The current set up has an axle limit of 7000 pounds (2 axles at 3500 pounds each). The trailer weighs 7500 pounds with no food, gas, or anything except the basic setup. Replacing the current axles with 5000 pound axles would give us the flexibility to safely carry the required food and water needed for each event, as well as give the trailer the capacity of holding all of the volunteers needed to prepare the meals without putting strain on the axles. At some point, the overstressed axles will become a real safety concern for the individuals towing and working in the Bird Feeder. Although the school district is not concerned but as the primary user the safety of the trailer and volunteers is something that always has to be considered.

Replace the food warmer thermostat, if approved and funded by the Boosters. There are times that we cannot get the food warmer above 135 degrees. We have added some insulation on one side of the warmer to help maintain the correct temperature. In order to add additional insulation the warmer needs to be unsecured and moved. One of the concerns with adding more insulation is that the warmer could overheat since it is currently wired to be either constantly on or off. Buying and installing a new thermostat, if we can find one to fit our warmer, would be a more economical option than trying to replace the warmer. There is no guarantee that replacing the thermostat would ensure the proper temperature but at least it would shut off before overheating.

Replace the Bird Feeder fridge, if approved and funded by the Boosters. There are times that we cannot get the fridge down to 41 degrees without adding bags of ice. We have to adjust the thermostat continually trying to get it to the right temperature, sometimes it works and sometimes it does not work. There are weight and size constraints that have to be considered with any new fridge.


