CREDIT RECOVERY

Summer Credit Recovery will be offered for students who failed a course. Summer credit recovery will begin on June 10th and ends on June 28th, 8am-12pm. More information will be communicated directly with students who fail a course.

SENIOR TRANSCRIPTS

All senior final transcripts should be sent by June 2nd. If you need a transcript sent during the summer go to parchment and make a request, https://www.parchment.com/u/registration/19511/account. Seniors, please note that transcript requests in Parchment are free through the month of June, but you are considered a graduate after June 30 in Parchment and will be charged for any transcript request made on or after July 1, 2024.



IMPORTANT REMINDERS CONCERNING SCHEDULES

- Changes will only be made for errors in the scheduling system. If a student did not request enough courses or failed to complete the process, that is not considered an error. Those students were placed in available courses.
- You must be in 6 classes per semester at BHS unless you are doing CCP classes off campus. It doesn't matter if you are a senior and you only "need" a couple credits, you still must take 6 classes per semester.
- If you didn't make a request for at least 6 classes we added classes to your schedule to make you a full-time student.
- Thank you Mr. O'Dell for posting the video about athletic eligibility. To clear some things up, for athletic eligibility you must be passing 5 units. All of our classes at BHS except PE will count towards a full unit. CCP classes could count as 2 units if they are 3 semester hours or more. If you are not taking a CCP class then you still must be in 6 classes.
- The CCP-off campus in your schedule is just a placeholder. It doesn't mean you have multiple CCP classes. It just tells us that you are not in the building for that period. You must talk to Mrs. Scohy to adjust your BHS schedule after you have been accepted for CCP and registered for your classes.
- Any necessary changes must be completed before the school year begins on August 14th. We will not change classes after school starts.
- NO changes will be made to accommodate teacher requests or to change course periods.

SENIOR YEARBOOK PICTURES

All senior photographs submitted for the yearbook must be taken by our contracted school photographer, Nicholas Studios. As we have done the past several years, Nicholas Studios will take pictures for the yearbook/composite this summer. On August 6th and August 7th from 9 am-12 pm and again from 1 pm-4 pm, Nicholas Studios will be in the high school library to take the yearbook/composite picture. Sitting fees must be paid at the time of this session. This will be a traditional head and shoulders portrait; please no t-shirts. Students may choose to visit other photographers for their complete senior portrait sessions; a yearbook/composite session is all that is necessary with Nicholas Studios. Please call (937) 848-6752 to schedule sittings during the summer months to take advantage of summer specials. The deadline to have a picture taken for the yearbook is December 31, 2024. Photos from sessions scheduled after this date will not be included in the senior section of the yearbook.
