A Review of the Regular Board Meeting

April 8, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President David Carpenter.

Roll Call was taken with board members David Carpenter, Audra Dorn, Karen Long, Kevin Price, and Virginia Slouffman present.

The Board heard a report or acted upon the following:

- Approved the minutes from the meetings of March 11 and March 24, 2021.
- Approved the Treasurer’s Report and approved expenditures for the month of March 2021.
- During Good News Recognition Mr. Carpenter presented a certificate to the high school Competition Cheer squad who earned runner-up status in the Ohio Association of Secondary School Principals Association State Championships.
- Stephen Bell second grade teachers Rachel Barker and Jill Culler presented Growth Mindset and Social Emotional Learning in the classroom. They shared their ideas about the importance of creating a positive classroom culture and some of the strategies they use to build strong relationships with their students and colleagues and how their teaching has changed their own growth mindset.
- Accepted a resignation from intermediate teacher Cynthia Rowden for the purpose of full Ohio STRS retirement effective end of May 2021.
- Approved supplemental duty coaches and district volunteers for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Approved teacher and support staff substitutes for the second semester of the 2020-2021 school year.
- Accepted a resignation from bus driver Virginia Saunders for the purpose of full Ohio SERS retirement July 31, 2021.
- Approved 2021 summer youth athletic camps for volleyball, cheerleading, baseball, softball, cross country, and both boys’ and girls’ basketball.
- Adopted a resolution for the purchase of one school bus.

- Approved an agreement with Sugarcreek Township for School Resource Officer services for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Approved out-of-state travel for the HS marching band to Indianapolis IN in November 2021; eighth graders to Washington DC in May 2022; Class of 2022 senior music students to New York City in May 2022; Classes of 2025 & 2026 to Washington DC at the end of May 2022; and HS marching band to Orlando FL in December 2022.
- Accepted *with gratitude* the following donations: An anonymous cash donation to the district in the amount of \$15,000 and Elijah & Brittany Etienne for 2 skids of water bottles (3,840 total bottles) to Stephen Bell Elementary.
- Approved revisions to current board of education policy.
- An executive session was held for the purpose of preparing for negotiations with public employees concerning their compensation and other terms and conditions of their employment.
