A Review of the Regular Meeting/Work Session August 26, 2021 7:00 p.m. Bellbrook Middle School

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President David Carpenter.

Roll Call was taken with board members David Carpenter, Audra Dorn, Mike Kinsey, Kevin Price, and Virginia Slouffman present.

The Board heard a report or acted upon the following:

- During "Good News" Recognition, Assistant Principal Jenna Hill described the Spring 2020-2021 awards earned by the BMS science department (Harold C. Shaw Award and the National Science League Award) and President Carpenter presented certificates of recognition to teachers Lynzee Allen, Kayla Bruggeman, Emily Cline, Crystal Current, Shelby Sigman, and Jennifer St. Pierre.
- Adam Remaly, district representative to the Greene County Career Center, presented an update
 on activities and the opening of the 2021-2022 school year. He discussed the new partnership
 between BSS and GCCC with the addition of Project Lead the Way engineering classes at BMS.
 The official dedication ceremony for the new Career Center building will be held this fall (date
 to be announced).
- Board Committee Reports included updates from Mr. Carpenter, OSBA Legislative Liaison, regarding HB 244 vaccines in public schools and in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Health released new quarantine guidelines for students exposed to COVID-19; Mrs. Dorn (BSEF/Financial Advisory) reported the Hall of Fame will induct new members on October 8 and the Fall Funtober Fest will occur on October 17 at BMS; Mr. Price indicated the next meeting of district Safety Committee will be held in September to address safety concerns including students walking to/from school, the inclusion of a crossing guard on Upper Bellbrook Road, and an upcoming meeting with AAA to seek assistance in the dismissal process at Bell Creek Intermediate; no report from Mrs. Slouffman (Greene County Business Advisory Council).

 County Public Health is increasing staff to meet the needs of contact tracing.
- The district Strategic Plan was reviewed. Director of Curriculum and Gifted Services, Betsy Gann explained the structure of the Strategic Planning Committee(s). District administrators

discussed Authentic Learning, Data Informed Instruction, Equity, Technology, Community Engagement, Whole Child Instruction, a Positive Learning Culture, district Safety and Finance.

- Named Audra Dorn as Ohio School Boards Association Capital Conference Alternate delegate and Mike Kinsey as the Student Achievement Liaison.
