## ***BOARD BITS***

### **A Review of the Board Meeting February 25, 2021 7:00 p.m. Bellbrook Middle School**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President David Carpenter.

Roll Call was taken with board members David Carpenter, Audra Dorn, Karen Long, Kevin Price, and Virginia Slouffman present.

#### **The Board heard a report or acted upon the following:**

- Approved the addition of fund 018-9000 Beach Bash student activity account fundraiser.
- Approved an advance in the amount of \$13,656.08 from the General Fund to the Title VI-B Federal Special Education grant (516-9121) until grant funds are received.
- Approved amendments to the FY 21 appropriations in the amount of (-\$108,970.37) for changes in grant allocations and a reduction in athletic revenues/expenditures.
- Approved tax rates as set by the Greene County Budget Commission – bond retirement rate is 4.31 mills.
- David Carpenter introduced Adam Remaly, the district’s new representative to the Greene County Joint Vocational School Board. Mr. Remaly shared highlights of the February meeting including CCP agreements with Sinclair Community College and vaccination schedule for GCC staff.
- Superintendent Cozad presented an update to the Performance Audit as prepared by the Ohio Auditor’s office and presented to the board in January 2020. This has been a continuous effort between the district and State Auditor’s office.
- Manager of Business, Jenness Sigman, presented a Comprehensive Maintenance Plan for our educational facilities and a Comprehensive Plan for Fleet Replacement of buses and other student transportation vehicles. Plans were developed based on recommendations from the State of Ohio Performance Audit.
- Board Committee Reports included David Carpenter with Legislative updates; Audra Dorn – BSEF & Financial Advisory; Kevin Price – Safety Committee; and Virginia Slouffman – GCESC Business Advisory Committee.
- The Board discussed the recent workshop held with the Ohio School Boards Association.
- Coordinator of Technology, Joshua Boles, discussed the districtwide program Securly. The program allows parents the opportunity to review their student’s internet searches while using district equipment/programs. This option provides the district with added internet and email security measures while providing students the opportunity to utilize technology in a safe and effect manor.

- Tabled approval of the 2021-2022 districtwide school calendar.
