TRAFFIC ALERT

Beginning soon, a project to realign and widen Carpenter Road at South Alpha-Bellbrook Road will commence, affecting some bus routes and traffic leaving from the back of Bellbrook Middle School. No traffic will be permitted to make a right-hand turn from the parking lot onto Carpenter. The road will be open to local traffic only and closed to through traffic at Prairie Trace. This project also will affect traffic on S. Alpha-Bellbrook, which will maintain through traffic at a greatly reduced capacity. Expect delays.
