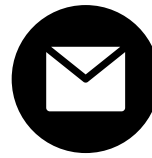

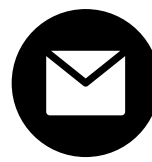

Camp Invention registration is open for students K-6. Make new discoveries this summer, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., June 19-23.

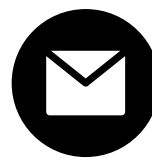
