1. Transportation Information

Updated bus information will be available Wednesday morning in the “Transportation Information” section of [FinalForms](#). This information will continue to be updated on a regular basis as we begin the school year. You will be able to see drop off/pick up times, bus numbers and bus stop location. Your student's information has already been pulled over to [FinalForms](#) from the previous school year, but you will need to log in and confirm the information and make all necessary changes.

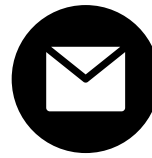

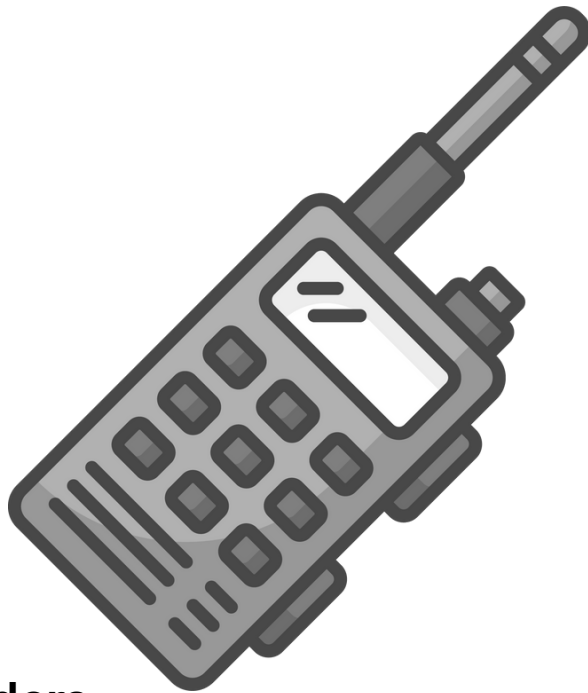

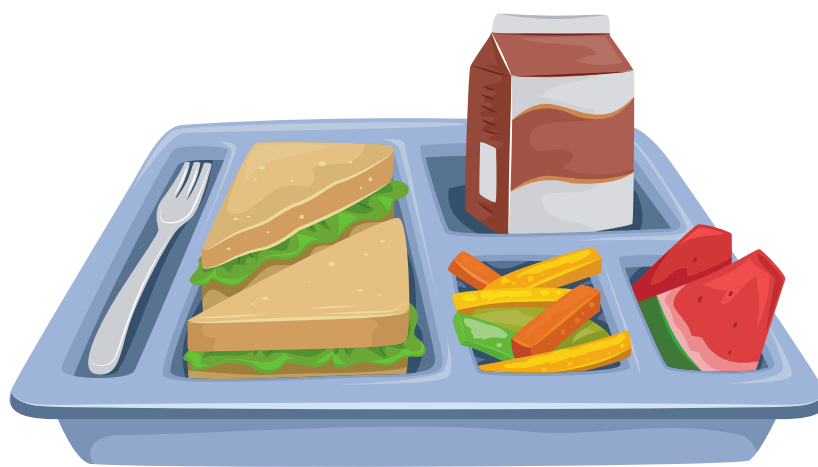
5. School Lunch Program Changes
