

The FAFSA is the form you complete on-line for federal financial aid.

Fill in the information on the Worksheet (your information and your parents' information) then make an appointment with Mrs. Tortorici to help you to file the information on-line. Call the BHS Guidance Office at 848-3737 ext. 2909 and sign-up to see me or email me at linda.tortorici@bss.k12.oh.us. You and you parent each need a **FSA ID** (Federal Student Aid ID) to "sign" the electronic form when you finish it on line. You and your parent can get your FSA ID at <https://fsaid.ed.gov/>. Complete the FAFSA before the college FAFSA deadline date. You will use your **2018** tax data (already filed). If your 2018 tax return has significant differences, you will need to tell the college financial aid office.

Documents Needed

In order to complete this years' FAFSA you will need records of your parents' income and your income (if you worked) earned in the two years prior to when you will start school. For the 2020-2021 school year you will need financial information from 2018.

You will need the following information:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Student driver's license (if any)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Student (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2018 Federal Income Tax Return. IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040 EZ
<input type="checkbox"/>	One parent's Social Security Number to be used as an electronic signature. <i>Be sure it is correct!</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Date (month/year) of a marriage, divorce or separation (for parent information)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Student's current bank statements (<i>Currently how much do you have in checking & savings?</i>)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your parents' current bank statements (<i>Currently how much do you have in checking & savings?</i>)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Student's current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond and other investment records
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your parents' current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond and other investment records.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A breakdown of parents' adjusted gross income according to each person's earnings.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Exact name & address info (spelling, abbreviations, etc.) at top of the IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040 EZ

To organize your information, complete a FAFSA on the Web Worksheet before you begin entering your information online. The worksheet will be available October 1st.

Keep these records! You may need them again. Do not mail your records to Federal Student Aid.
