FAFSA INFORMATION

Must create FSA ID accounts at least three days BEFORE filing the FAFSA. The student will need a FSA ID and, in most cases, at least one contributor (parent) will need a FSA ID. A Social Security number (SSN), email address and mobile phone number can only be associated with one FSA ID. Parents without an SSN will still need to obtain an FSA ID.

To create a FSA ID, go to www.studentaid.gov and click on the blue "Create Account" located on the right of the webpage.

Once the FSA ID has been confirmed, a student may start their FAFSA by going to www.studentaid.gov and click on the blue "FAFSA Form" which will drop down. Then click on the blue "Complete FAFSA Form".
