REPORTS AND ITEMS OF INFORMATION

- 1. Representatives from Sugarcreek Township presented a proposal for the construction of a Veterans Memorial on Pine Court or near the water tower at the corner of Upper Bellbrook and Feedwire Roads.
- 2. Dr. Cozad reviewed the transportation changes for the 2022-2023 school year which would increase bus routes utilizing three tiers of routes instead of the current two. The size of the transportation ineligibility zones will be decreased in order to restore bus service for many students including high school. Implementing the changes would require an adjustment in school start and end times.
- 3. The board reviewed the proposed 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school calendars. Adoption will occur at a future meeting.
