

The Bellbrook-Sugarcreek Board of Education met in a special session on March 24, 2021 via live stream.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Mr. David Carpenter.

ATTENDANCE:

Roll Call: Mr. David Carpenter, Mrs. Audra Dorn, Mrs. Karen Long, Mr. Kevin Price and Mrs. Virginia Slouffman.

Superintendent Doug Cozad detailed the current status of district finances after four phases of budget reductions totaling over \$4,800,000 since 2018. Reductions have included supplemental duty positions for clubs/activities/athletics, transportation, and 33 staff positions.

**MOTION 21-70**                      **RESOLUTION**

Moved by Mrs. Slouffman, seconded by Mrs. Dorn to approve a resolution designating districtwide priorities regarding the May 4, 2021 Emergency Operating Levy that would yield \$3,220,000 (4.9 mills).

If the levy passes, for the 2021-22 school year the district will:

- Reinstate K-5 STEM program
- Reinstate supplemental positions for 31 clubs/activities/athletics
- Reinstate two (2) district library specialist positions

If the levy does not pass, for the 2021-22 school year the district will:

- Reduce up to three (3) K-12 staffing positions through attrition
