• Cut Time/Charms Rollover

- In 64 days it's going to switch to another program and we need to download our data.

Uniform Bag Conditions

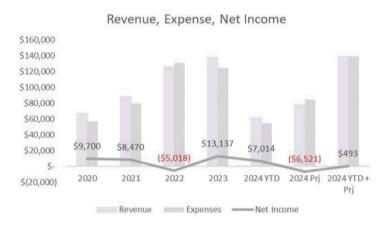

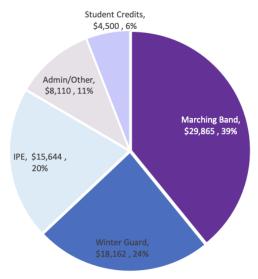
