The district is rural and suburban and consists of the City of Bellbrook (population 7100) and Sugarcreek Township (population 8200). Every year approximately 2 members of the senior class receive recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program. The class of 2020 had 1 Semi-Finalist.

Faculty: There are 53 faculty members and more than 75% hold advanced degrees.

Advanced Placement: Formal Advanced Placement courses are offered in: Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, Environmental Science, Spanish Language, French Language, Music Theory, Biology, Chemistry, English Language and English Literature, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Government and Politics – U.S., and U.S. History. Advanced Placement Examination: In May of 2020, 136 students took 224 exams. Seventy-nine percent of test takers received a 3, 4 or 5. Advanced Placement classes do receive weight for GPA.

Honors/Scholarship Classes: Honors level English courses are offered in the 9th and 10th grades. Scholarship courses are offered in Mathematics in Geometry, Algebra 2 and Pre-calculus. Grades earned in these courses do receive extra weighting for GPA.

Career Education Programs: Bellbrook High School is affiliated with The Greene County Career Center located just outside of Xenia, Ohio. The Career Center offers over 20 program choices. Project Lead the Way, a national pre-college engineering program, was introduced at BHS during the 2007-2008 school year.

College Credit Plus Option: In the 2019-20 school year, over 200 students took courses for college credit, both on campus at BHS and at local colleges/universities. Credit is awarded and grades are weighted in the GPA. Current College Credit Plus courses at BHS are: Spanish III, Spanish IV, Supply Chain Management, Chinese, College English 12, AP Statistics, Intro to Engineering, Digital Electronics, Civil Engineering and Architecture, Engineering Development and Design, and EGR 1010.
